
Chord Theory

C Major Harmonized Scale Drill



- All chords/triads are born out of the Major Scale
- There's a unique chord/triad for every note in the Scale (e.g. Harmonized Scale)
- Triads are built by stacking diatonic thirds (starting with Root Note and taking every other note from the Scale; 1-3-5)
- Letter names and sequence for all notes in each triad stay the same for ALL KEYS—just add #'s or b's from key signature
- Familiarity with the C Major
 Harmonized Scale is helpful for
 knowing the chords for ALL KEYS
- *Exercise: Drill the C Harmonized Scale by speaking the triads in order in under 7 secs (CEG, DFA, EGB...)--drill ascending and descending the Scale
