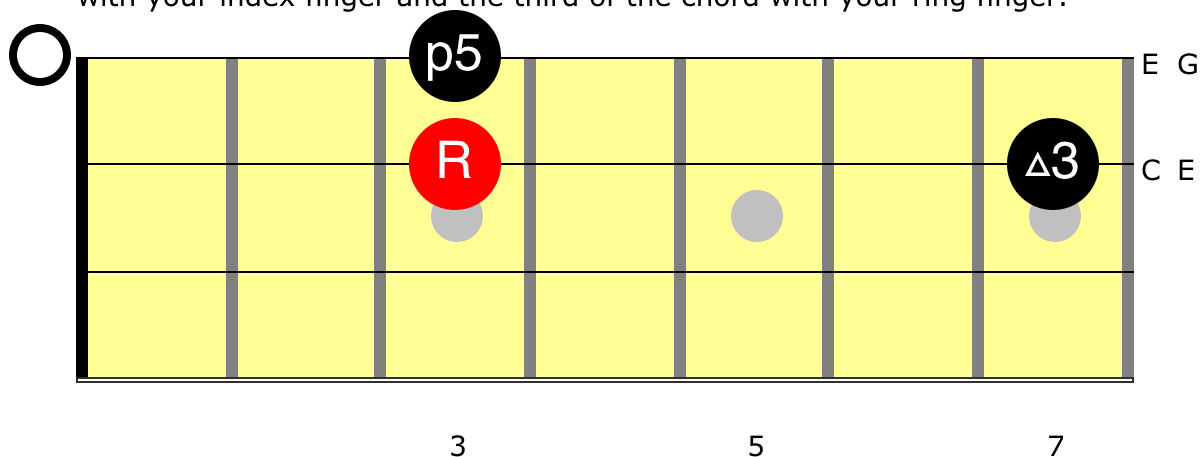
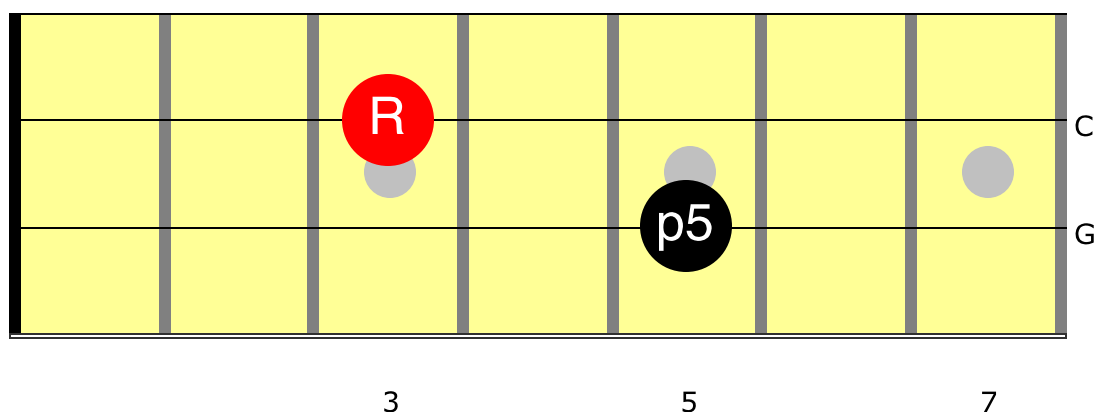


STARTING POINTS FOR C MAJOR DOUBLE STOP SERIES

A & E STRINGS: There are two separate double stops listed here. The first uses the open E string with the C note or Root of the chord. This is the second shape in our double stop series or the MEDIUM double stop, but feels different because of the open E string. Play the C note (root) with your middle finger. The second double stop on these string is comprised of the 3rd and the 5th of the chord. It is the LONG double stop in this series. Play the 5th of the chord with your index finger and the third of the chord with your ring finger.



D & A STRINGS: Start with the SHORT double stop shape, skipping one fret between notes.



G & D STRINGS: Start with the MEDIUM double stop, skipping 2 frets between notes.
