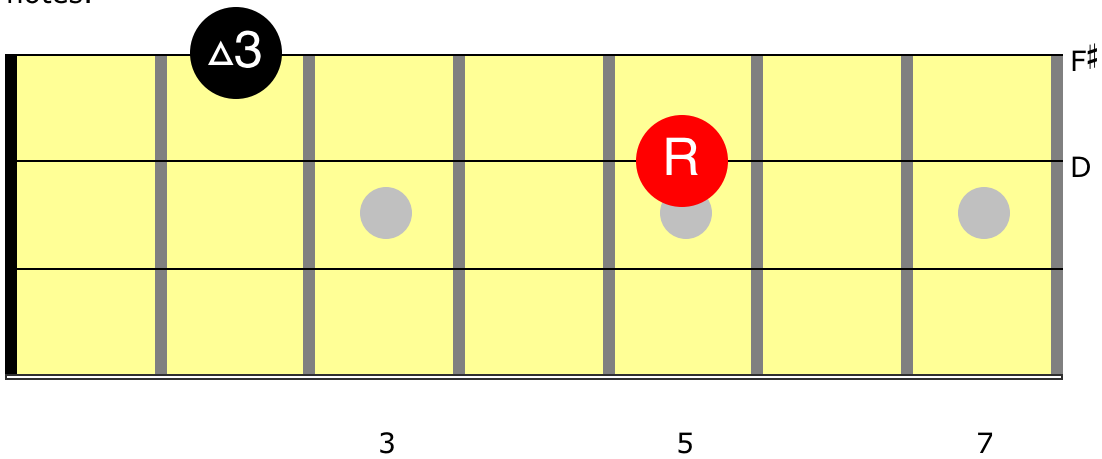
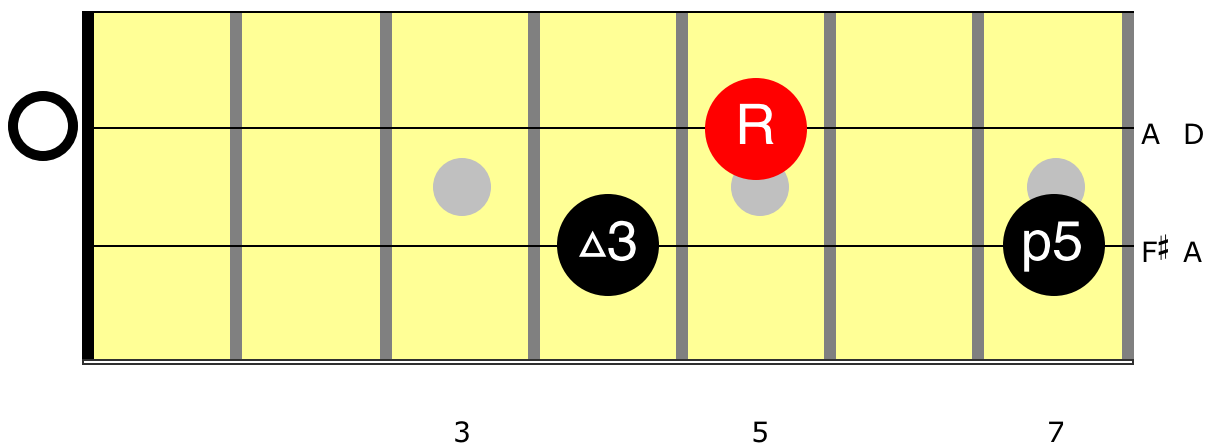


## STARTING POINTS FOR D MAJOR DOUBLE STOP SERIES

A & E STRINGS: Start with MEDIUM double stop, skipping two frets between notes.



D & A STRINGS: There are two separate double stops shown here. The first includes the open A string and the F# (4th fret) on the D string. This is the LONG double stop, but feels different because of the open A string. Play the F# (4th fret) with the middle finger. The next double stop is the SHORT double stop. Play the Root with the middle finger and the 5th with the ring finger.



G & D STRINGS: There are two separate double stops shown here. The first includes the open D String and the A (2nd fret) on the G string. This is the SHORT double stop, but feels different because of the open D string. Play the A note with your index finger. The second double stop is the MEDIUM double stop. Play the F# (4th fret on the D String) with your index finger and the D (7th fret on the G string) with your ring finger.
